MASS INTENTIONS

Priests around the diocese have been reminded to accept only one stipend per Mass (canon 948). If a Mass is booked and a stipend has been given then no other stipend can be taken for that Mass.
 This provision of Canon Law, that has always existed but has not been always followed, exists on the one hand to protect the holiness of the Mass (Mass is not a show where one has to pay for a ticket), on the other hand to prevent that Mass intentions become a sort of 'paid indulgence', where we try to buy God's power of salvation. And that is a sin, called simony.
 The donations go to the Parish for the maintenance of the priest.

Week 7 – 4th June

We are grateful to all the priests and deacons involved in the Assembly and to all the clergy for their support of this process. We pray that God will bless their ministry with fruitfulness.

Our diocesan Assembly is a response to last year’s Synod listening process, and was promised in the Diocesan Synod report. It is happening on 15th July, 2023, at Thornton College. At the Assembly we will have the opportunity to look again at the main themes arising from the Synod listening, moving to concrete actions as we discern the future of our diocese together. Delegates will be brought together from every Catholic community across the diocese, by invite only in order to ensure a diversity of ages, ethnicities and ministries. Delegates will be asked to take part in four sessions of preparation from late May, organised in pastoral areas, with a zoom option on a Saturday morning. Some key ideas we will be exploring include:

- Being open to the Holy Spirit
- Stepping away from our own agenda
- Discerning the divine
- Focusing on the long term, and moving forward
